Dates & Locations of Walks: START TIME OF 8:00 am

April 27th: Lehigh Valley Trail at Rochester Junction entrance on Plains Road. [www.mendonfoundation.com](http://www.mendonfoundation.com).

May 4th: Hundred Acres Park - Located at 250 Rush Scottsville Rd. (State Route 251), west of the intersection with East River Road, on the north side of 251. From the intersection of Rush Scottsville Rd. (Rte. 251) and East River Road, travel west for one mile on Rte. 251. Hundred Acres Park is on your right, past the railroad tracks and the Railroad Museum.
